
Sub: Re-monetisation- Facilitating opening of Bank Accounts by Textile Workers and adoption of Unified Payments Interface (UPI)

The first Impact of Re-monetisation Reforms is likely to be on the payment of wages to workers of textile units including garmenting units. A large segment of the workers were traditionally being paid in cash as they were not having bank accounts. In order to ensure payment of wages through the bank transfer mode, it is necessary that textile units register the details of the workers who already have bank accounts. Further, Textile units have to organize camps for opening bank accounts for workers who don't have accounts. This action may be taken by all the member Textile Units of your association on a priority basis.

Special efforts should also be made to adopt the **Unified Payments Interface (UPI)** which is an open and inclusive digital payment platform developed by National Corporation of India (NPCI). Facilitation camps may also be organized for adoption of UPI by Textile workers.

Ministry of Textiles seeks your support in this regard so the payment of wages is effected to textile workers through bank transfer and cash-less mode of payments.
