

As you are aware, the Advance Authorization Scheme allows import of inputs for export production without payment of Customs duties. The scheme is very popular and is being widely used by the exporters.

However, exporters have been representing regarding the problem faced by them due to delay in the cancellation of Bond/BG by the Customs. It has been pointed out that it takes many years to get the Bond/BG cancelled.

The Council has taken up this problem with the Government at various levels. The Government has now sought details of Advance Authorization against which Bond/BG remain pending for cancellation.

In case, you have any Advance Authorization against which Bond/BG remain pending for cancellation at the Customs, please send us the details in the following format:

Since the matter is time bound and urgent, we would request you to kindly send us the above details immediately not later than 06-11- 2015 as it has to be submitted to the Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, Government of India.
